
DINA AND ISPENT TWO WEEKS IN JESSY COHEN.


1 WAS BORN IN IRAQ

SO THEN WE CAME HERE AND LIVED IN A TRANSIT CAMP IN TENTS.




A CHRISTIAN PRIEST WAS THERE







WHEN THE MAYOR CAME TO VISIT, PEOPLE THREW TOMA TOES AND POTATOES AT HIM.


